4. Our Facility

Destiny House Farm:

The Revive! South Africa GAP Program's home base is our farm, Destiny House Farm. It is a picturesque 10-hectare estate nestled in the serene Breswoll area, just outside the bustling city of Spring on the Eastrand in Gauteng, South Africa. Conveniently located a mere twenty-five-minute drive from OR Tambo International Airport, Africa's largest and primary international airport, it offers a tranquil retreat from the urban hustle.





At Destiny House Farm, we not only cultivate a variety of vegetables including soya beans, spinach, potatoes, tomatoes, chilies, and lettuce, but we also nurture a small community of animals, including chickens, geese, Muscovy ducks, with plans to introduce pigs, goats, and sheep in 2025. In addition to our agricultural pursuits, we regularly host leadership development youth camps for high school learners, providing them with immersive experiences in nature.

Accommodating up to forty people at a time, our facility includes a dorm room area, a charming main house that boasts a fully equipped kitchen, a cozy living room, three bedrooms, and a designated area for gatherings and a 'lekker' South African braai (barbecue). The farm features two boreholes supplying fresh, clean drinking water and is fully powered with electricity, ensuring a comfortable and safe environment for all guests.





Furthermore, our on-site small church hosts monthly services, adding a spiritual dimension to the farm's ambiance. Within a 25 km (15,5 mile) radius, numerous shopping centers and malls cater to every need, completing the convenience and appeal of Destiny House Farm as an ideal destination for retreats, gatherings, and wholesome rural experiences.

5. Meals & Food Preferences

Our Chef and kitchen manager, Marianne Fitzpatrick, takes a lot of pride in providing participants with nutritious and fresh meals on a daily basis. Our focus is on promoting health and well-being through organic, locally sourced vegetables, fruits, and free-range meat.

Each participant will receive three meals a day, carefully crafted to offer a balance of essential nutrients. For breakfast, options range from wholesome cereals, fresh fruits and yougart, to a hearty South African farm breakfast featuring eggs, bacon, toast, mushrooms,



and a sausage/cheese griller. Lunch typically includes a protein source such as chicken, fish, beef, lamb, or pork, paired with a refreshing salad, and a starch like bread, rice, or pasta. Supper comprises a well-rounded meal with a protein source and a vegetable option such as potatoes, carrots, cauliflower, spinach, beans, pumpkin, or a stir-fry mix, accompanied by a starch like rice, bread, or pasta.

When we go on an excursion, we will either pack lunch, dine at a restaurant, or purchase our meals from food vendors.

We understand that dietary preferences and specific nutritional needs vary, so participants are encouraged to indicate any preferences or dietary requirements on their registration form, and we will do our best to accommodate these requests.

Keegan serves as the Destiny Farm Manager and is also our team bus driver who will do his utmost best to ensure safe transportation to all destinations. For the more leisure-inclined visitor, Clarens boasts a thriving art scene, numerous boutique and craft shops, and an 18-hole golf course. One thing is for sure, you'll never be shy of ways to stay entertained in this awesome little town.

Golden Gate National Park:

At the foot of Lesotho's Maluti Mountains, the Golden Gate Highlands National Park will literally leave you high with inspiration with endless horizons, overlooking the vast beauty that is South Africa. Spend time in the majestic Maluti Mountains, hiking, horse riding, exploring caves and much more in their indescribable golden glow. The vulture's restaurant (bird hide) welcomes birders to a proper vulture



feast. Black wildebeest, eland, blesbok, oribi, springbok and burchell's zebra graze in the wild, grassy pastures, while rare bearded vultures circle the skies above the lost pathways of the San hunter-gathers, who once dwelled in the park's caves. It is the ideal escape if you long to stretch your legs, breathe fresh mountain air and let nature lift your soul with its majestic beauty.

Basotho Culture Village:



Basotho Cultural Village will transport you back in time and take you on an incredible journey where a Basotho chief offers you mombothi (sorghum beer) to enjoy. Demonstrations of the decorations of huts, making of basketware, crushing of maize and traditional dances are also shown. Your tour will commence at the Khatloa under the expert guidance of a tour guide. From there you will see a rest camp that resembles an

18th-century Sotho village combined with replica homesteads dating from the 16th century to the present day. The village offers a unique South African experience in which you can learn about traditional Sotho arts and crafts and their way of life.

KwaZulu-Natal:

• PheZulu Cultural and Safari Park, Valley of a Thousand Hills: Come experience the Zulu culture first-hand! On arrival, you will be taken into traditional beehive-shaped thatched huts, where the various artifacts, beliefs, and rituals of the Zulu people will be explained, giving you an insight into the fascinating traditions, customs, and culture of the Zulupeople. The 50-minute Zulu dancing show is impressive with



the dancers in their traditional atire, showing off their skills with grace, agility, and humor. PheZulu also has a Crocodile and Snake park where you will be taken on a guided tour by a knowledgeable local guide. You will learn interesting facts about crocodiles and snakes and have a hands-on experience with Cleo the Burmese python who weighs in at 42 kilograms.

• Durban City Tour:



Spend a full day discovering the diverse culture and history of Durban and visiting the city's sights. This is the ideal introductory tour of Durban, which has been shaped by the early Colonial settlers, the indigenous Zulus, and the Indians who arrived as indentured laborers in the 19th Century. Travel along the Golden Mile, the revitalized beachfront promenade, viewing the upgraded Point

Waterfront. The tour then travels through the City, viewing the majestic City Hall and the small craft harbor. Afterwards, drive past the sugar terminals and harbor warehouses on the way to the University of Natal for the view below. Then the tours visits the bustling African/Indian Markets at Warwick Triangle – home to 9 distinct markets developed around Durban's largest public transport interchange. The tour ends with a visit to the peaceful Durban Botanic Gardens,

founded in 1849, and the Moses Mabhida Stadium (Optional cable car ride for your own account to the top of the Stadium for that phenomenal view of Durban).

• Durban Harbor Boat Cruise:

This tour will take you on an unforgettable trip around Durban. Durban Harbor is the biggest and busiest harbor in the southern hemisphere. The harbor tour are very educational, as the boat takes the passengers to points of interest in Africa's largest harbor and shows them the route through which ships enter the harbor, discharge cargo, and exit. The skipper will teach the



passengers about the port and its operation. If the weather conditions are favorable, the boat may go further out from the shore. The skipper is in close contact with the passengers and will give you a comprehensive guided tour. The trip will either take you down the Maydon Wharf Channel or to the City and Cor Container terminal.

uShaka Marine World:

A world-class entertainment theme park and tourism destination located on Durban's Golden Mile. We bring together cultures, like no other place in Africa – into a safe, secure and clean environment that resonates the sound of fun, laughter and the spirit of togetherness. uShaka Marine World is a 16-hectare theme park. It comprises of 8 attractions: uShaka Sea World, uShaka Wet 'n Wild, uShaka Sea Animal Encounters Island, uShaka Beach, uShaka Village Walk, uShaka Kids World,



uShaka Dangerous Creatures and Chimp & Zee. uShaka Sea World is the fifth largest aquarium in the world. uShaka Wet 'n Wild water park has the highest slide in Africa. Sea World boasts an impressive Dolphin Stadium, seating over 1 200 spectators, a Seal Stadium, a host of fun-filled seal shows, as well as the Penguin Rookery, home to over 63 African Penguins. It also features the largest aquarium in the southern hemisphere. With spectacular views of the Indian Ocean and fun activities, it provides quality entertainment for everyone.

Dolphin Coast:



The Dolphin Coast refers to the northern coast of KwaZulu-Natal and is so named for the schools of Bottlenose Dolphins that leap out of the warm waters of the Indian Ocean, to the delight of spectators. The three main towns on the Dolphin Coast are Umdloti, Umhlanga, and Ballito, which are all prime holiday hotspots for their undeniable beauty and almost year-round subtropical climate. The Dolphin Coast offers visitors a combination of modern facilities at most of its sun-drenched




